Additional scarf necklaces will make their debut in late summer. Karey also plans to add her handmade crocheted scarves to her stunning, fashionable line of accessories, as well as specially designed necklace carrying cases.

While being a must-have item for fashionable females everywhere, for the woman who has everything a scarf necklace also makes for a standout gift that is sure to be an appreciated addition to any jewelry collection.

Some ways to wear Karey's chic and unique scarf necklaces include:

1. Fold the necklace in half asymmetrically so that one stone is hanging higher than the other, then wrap it around your neck and pull the stones through the loop created when you first folded the chain in half.
2. Hold one stone in front of you and then wrap the chain all the way around.
3. Start with step #2 and then fold one stone over the other side.
